



Going to a tea party, but do not have a hat to wear?

### What to get:

- Find a large piece of paper (butcher paper works great, or a full section of a newspaper)
- Get a small to medium sized mixing bowl
- You will also need tape (masking tape works best, ask your mom or dad if you don't know what it is.)
- Glue will be helpful to add all kinds of great things, like ribbons or cutouts of flowers, or buttons, or anything you would like to add to your hat.

### What to do:

- Place the bowl in the center of the paper underneath it. Then mold the paper over the outside of the bowl as best as you can, and use the masking tape to tape all the way around the bottom part of the bowl.
- Once you have the tape in place you can lift it off of the bowl and see how it fits to your head. If you need to adjust it, pinch it a little bit tighter and add some more tape.
- Once that is done, roll the edges of the paper toward the center (rolling it up, not down). Roll it just enough to give your hat a nice big **brim**.
- Use the glue to add ribbon to the bottom of the side crown (see picture). Then you can add anything else you would like!
