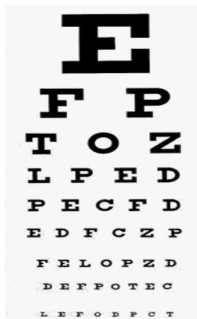


Male hamsters are called “boars,”
